



# Cantigny Tank Park

## What will you see in our Tank Park?

We have 10 tanks in our tank park at Cantigny. We also have an Armored Personnel Carrier and four artillery pieces. They are all inoperable displays of United States Army equipment.

1. M1917 Tank; WWI. A two man, six-ton tank. The U.S. version of the French Renault FT 17.
2. M5 Stuart Tank; 1941, WWII.
3. M24 Chaffee Tank; 1944, WWII through Cold War.
4. M41 Walker/Bulldog; 1950's Cold War.
5. T26E4 Pershing Tank; 1945, WWII, Korea, Cold War. This was a test model for the M26 heavy tank.
6. M46 Patton Tank; 1950's, Korea, Cold War.
7. M47 Patton Tank; 1950's Cold War.
8. M48 Patton Tank; 1965, Vietnam.
9. M551 Sheridan Tank; 1963, and in Vietnam. This tank was still used by other divisions in Desert Storm, 1991.
10. M60 Patton Tank; 1970, Cold War. The 1st Infantry Division used this tank in West Germany. Other divisions used the M60 from 1969 in Vietnam to 1991 in Desert Storm.

The M113 APC was used by the 1st Division in Vietnam, 1965. Modified versions of the M113 APC remained in use in Kosovo, 2000.

We have an M4A3E8 Sherman Tank in the First Division Museum. This tank was used in WWII.

The French Schneider Tank in the First Division Museum is a wooden reproduction.
